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- Any collection of personalized data for statistical purposes to compile statistical data will be done with precise rules concerning the precise purpose, the duration of conservation and the potential recipients of these data. Those rules have to be approved by companies that participate before collection of the data. This data can only be put at disposition of participants in an aggregated manner. Databases have to be produced and maintained according to rules as provided by the legislator.
- » For every meeting a precise agenda has to be provided with the invitation and has to be formally approved during every meeting. Meeting minutes and a list of participation will be provided for approval to any members of any statutory group, working groups and/or commissions within a reasonable timing. The meeting minutes will report in case of occurrence, any dispute in relation with confidentiality and/or potential or evident violation of anti-trust rules.








Luxembourg Logistics Ranking Logistics Performance Index








Indice de performance logistique (IPL) Banque mondiale

Digitization E-CMR enhance efficiency



Pilot Project: electronic consignment note (e-CMR)

It is possible to use the updated electronic consignment note or e-CMR in countries that have ratified the use in Europe. Luxembourg has now introduced a projet de loi on the UNECE e-cmr Protocol that should pass ratification in the next months.

Luxembourg decided to join a Benelux pilot project that will enable participating companies to use the e-CMR documents in Belgium, the Netherlands & Luxembourg.

The Luxembourg approach was aligned with B (signed <u>e-cmr UNECE Protocol</u> and implements the <u>BENELUX</u> pilot) & NL (has signed & ratified the <u>UNECE Protocol</u>).

• <u>BENELUX</u> pilot starts on December 1st 2017 and will run for three years. Transport between Benelux countries as well as <u>BENELUX</u> transport and cabotage.

Digitization E-CMR reduced costs through efficiency



Pilot Project: electronic consignement note (e-CMR)

 e-CMR a COST SAVING MEASURE: reduction of 4.5 € administrative costs/CMR

Faster administration (reduced data entry, no paper Handling)

The CMR Convention (1956) also makes it mandatory to use a paper consignment note, unless countries have joined the <u>UNECE</u> convention's e-protocol (2008). If two bordering countries have ratified the <u>UNECE</u> eprotocol, road haulage is possible between them by carrying an accompanying electronic consignment note. This e-CMR procedure is aimed to reduce costs and enhance efficiency. <u>12</u> member states <u>have signed or ratified the UNECE e-CMR protocol</u> and more are working at an implementation.



Lithuania vs Luxembourg



Posted Workers EU Directive in Transport

General Problems in posting

- Bus round-trip not accepted as transit
- No changes of posting form during transport (e.g. change of driver or car, additional delivery orders)
- Internet application: reusable/savable form only in F
- Form A1: for every transport, "nightmare" to get
- Labour contract: data protection problem (clients start demanding as well)
- Third-party representatives: data protection problems, costs
- Order/delivery: only 5 deliveries possible in registration form
- Minimum wage: no general certification available, information not in E




















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
